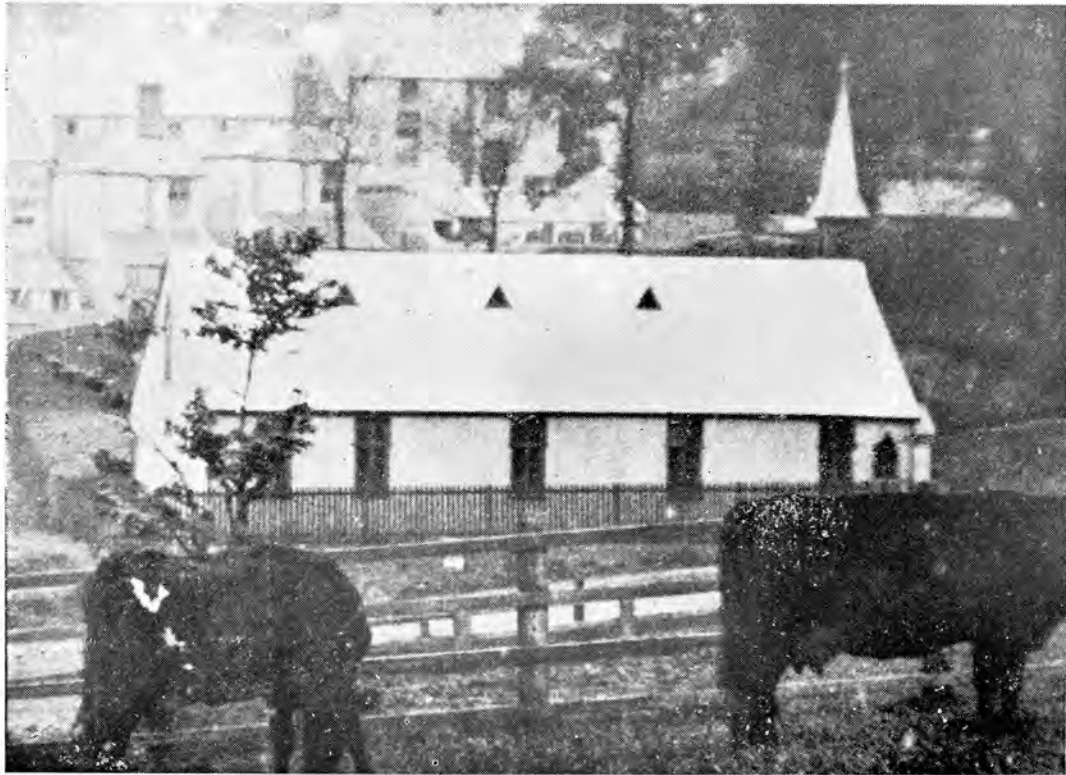

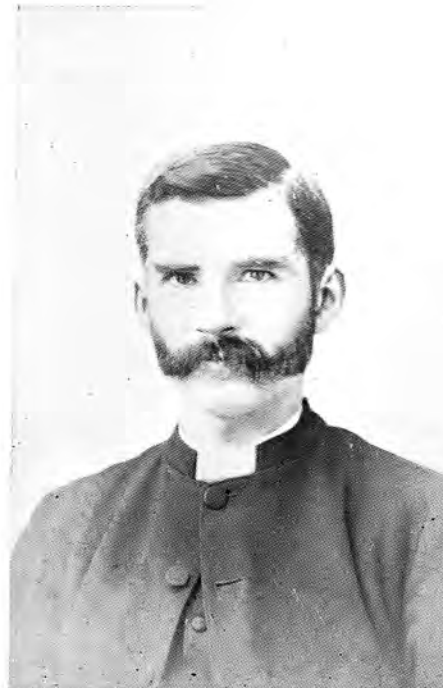

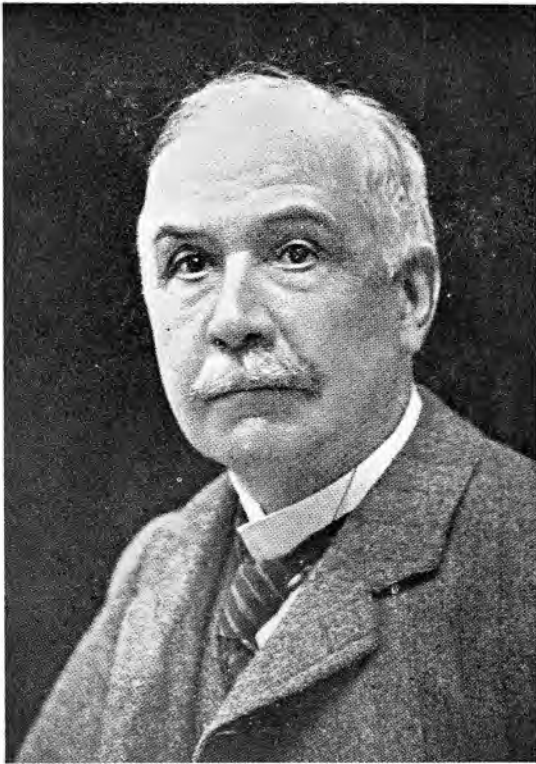
S. Michael's Iron Church, Rhyddings Park Road.



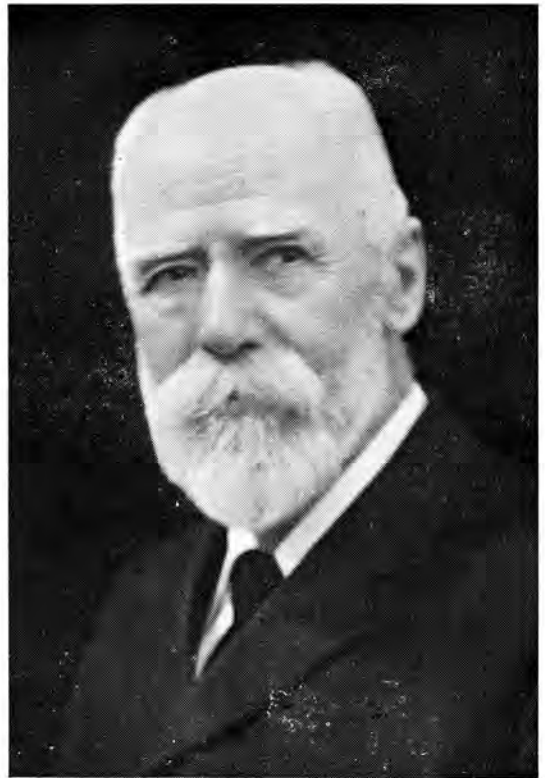

S. GABRIEL'S CHURCH.

The Church is a beautiful building in the 15th Century style. Nearly all its ornaments are gifts from members of the congregation, or memorials. The high altar and reredos, together with the parclose screens round the Lady Chapel are a memorial to those of this parish who fell in the Great War. The fine Rood Screen was given by Mr. J. R. Davies and Dr. Leighton Davies, in memory of Miss Mary Davies. The East window was also given by Dr. Leighton Davies, in memory of Mr. J. R. Davies. He also presented the church with its first set of Eucharistic vestments. The three windows in the Lady Chapel were given in memory of Capt. Thomas Llewelyn Morgan by his widow. Those on the South side of the Sanctuary were given in memory of Miss Amy Edwards and Miss Ellie Cole, by friends. All the windows are by the late Mr. Archibald Nicholson. The choir stalls are the bequest of Col. W. Ll. Morgan—our chief benefactor—who also left money for the extension of the church and the choir vestry. He also gave the pulpit and lectern. The reredos in the Lady Chapel was given as a thankoffering after a mission. The altar ornaments are the bequest of Miss Margaret Withington. The candlesticks on the high altar are the gift of Mrs. King, in memory of her son, Mr. Fred. King. The marble paving in the Chancel is a memorial to the late beloved vicar, the Rev. John Pollock. The sacred vessels were given by the communicants, and a second chalice by Miss A. M. Hardy; a silver flagon, by Mr. and Mrs. Salter, in memory of their son. The ciborium in the tabernacle was given by Mrs. New and Mrs. Tallack, in memory of Ronald New. The Stations of Cross, and innumerable other articles are gifts of members of the congregation. All the ornaments are good, and not the smallest thing is unworthy of the church and of its use in the worship of Almighty God.
